



CALL FOR ENROLMENT IN THE PREPARATORY NON-DEGREE PROGRAM Music Education

The University of Ljubljana Academy of Music is now accepting applications for its Preparatory Non-Degree Program, which is designed to prepare candidates for the audition of musical and artistic talent required for admission into the Bachelor's Degree in Music Education program.

Candidates have the option to select one or more courses from the variety offered. The total instructional hours are different for individual and group lessons. One teaching period (TP) lasts for 45 minutes.

The lessons will take place in April and May. Precise dates will be agreed between the participants and the teacher of each course.

List of courses:

1. Complimentary Piano	2 TPs
2. Vocal Technique	2 TPs
3. Playing Choral Score	2 TPs
4. Singing and Playing Piano Accompaniments	2 TPs
5. Solfeggio	10 TPs (5 sessions of 2 TPs each)
6. Music Theory	4 TPs
7. Harmony	4 TPs
8. Counterpoint	4 TPs
9. Selected Chapters from the History of Music	4 TPs
10. Development of Teaching Skills	4 TPs

Course structure:

- Complimentary Piano and Vocal Technique courses are offered as one-on-one sessions.
- The Playing Choral Score and Singing and Playing Piano Accompaniments courses are held in small groups, with a minimum of three participants required to form a group.
- All remaining courses are conducted in larger groups settings, provided there are at least five candidates.

Admission criteria: The Preparatory Non-Degree Program welcomes applications from individuals who aim to participate in the audition for the Bachelor's Degree in Music Education. Eligible candidates include those presently enrolled in secondary music education programs, students from other secondary school programs who have selected music as their elective matura subject, or those who have completed any secondary school program prior to 1 June 1995.

Candidate selection will be based on their curriculum vitae, which should detail their musical education and training to date, as well as on the provided documentation of their acquired musical qualifications.

The number of available places for courses numbered 5 through 10 is 20. For courses numbered 1 to 4, availability depends on the number of available professors.
