	 a demo recording – audio or video (MP3 file or link, max. 1 year old) Instrumentalists At least two movements or pieces: one movement/piece must be by a Viennese Classicist (Haydn, Mozart, Beethoven) or related composer, one from a stylistic era of your choice (one of these movements/ pieces must be slow, and the other one fast). Singers At least 2 arias: one aria by W.A. Mozart, the second aria of your own choice. Composers Composers are requested to send a recording (MP3 file) and scores of three compositions (as a PDF file). For further information, please visit www.isa-music.org
