We would like to inform you that next

**isa – International Summer Academy (isa20)
of the mdw – University of Music and Performing Arts Vienna**

will be taking place **from 16 to 30 August 2020** in the Semmering region of southern Lower Austria.

In its 30th year, isa will once again be offering merit-based scholarships for which graduate and postgraduate (as well as highly advanced undergraduate) students with performance experience nominated by your university may compete.

We are happy to be able to offer a total of 35 scholarships for students nominated to compete for them by isa's privileged scholarship partner universities. (Please find attached a list of all partners.)

These scholarships can only be awarded to students who would be attending **an entire masterclass** (two weeks).

Please note that we have only very limited financial latitude to grant scholarships for the Masterclass for Voice!

Following this, your students will need to register online and upload the required demo recordings by 15 April 2020 at the latest.

Final decisions with regard to acceptance will be made by isa during May 2020.
