## CREATE AN ALPINE YOUTH ORCHESTRA TAKE PART IN A CHAMBER MUSIC MASTERCLASS

Candidates must be between 18 and 25 years of age. Younger musicians will be considered on receipt of the necessary parental permission.

The following instrumentalists are required for the ALPINE YOUTH ORCHESTRA: violin, viola, cello, double bass, flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, horn, trumpet, trombone, kettledrum players and percussionists

The chamber music masterclass is open to all instrumentalists.

The selection process will take place at Fondazione Luigi Bon, in Colugna di Tavagnacco (UD – ITALY) and/or other locations if the number of candidates is regarded as sufficient and come from the same geographical area.

The musicians will receive piano accompaniment on request presented, together with the appropriate score, when they register.

Candidates will be examined on a free programme lasting a minimum of 20 minutes, to which the panel of judges will listen for as long as they deem necessary.

## A) ALPINE YOUTH ORCHESTRA

Successful candidates will be invited to play in the new ALPINE YOUTH ORCHESTRA, which will be based at Fondazione Luigi Bon, in Colugna di Tavagnacco (UD).

The rehearsal and concert calendar will be published at a later date.

Grants and reimbursement of expenses as calculated by the organizers will be available.

## B) CHAMBER MUSIC MASTERCLASS

Musicians will be able to attend the chamber music masterclass free of charge. Furthermore, ensembles achieving a suitable musical standard will be invited to perform one or more concerts in selected festivals and musical seasons. The head teacher and chief coordinator will be Prof.ssa Federica Repini. Grants and reimbursement of expenses as calculated by the organizers will be available. Ensembles taking part in concerts will receive remuneration.

Students agree to pay Fondazione Luigi Bon a compulsory fee of € 30,00 for each lesson the student misses.
