The **EUphony Orchestra** is based on the cooperation of University of Music and Performing Arts Graz with its southeastern partners in Zagreb, Ljubljana, Budapest, Belgrade and Sarajevo. Efforts to develop future-oriented and exemplary ways for Orchestral training began in September 2015 with the Symposium "Innovative orchestra studies for artistic development and employability – Identification of the context" at the University of Music and Performing Arts Graz together with Universities of Zurich and Den Haag, Clemens Hellsberg, Dietmar Flury, Dirk Kaftan and Philippe Herreweghe. As a result, Daniel Geiss was asked to make his concept of an orchestral academy part of the EUphony Orchestra project.
